

DRAMA

Ask your students to act out scenes of Paul's family's every day life. They'll be able to improvise and practise role-play and vocabulary through simple communicative situations. It's not necessary to follow a predetermined script.

AIM: to develop children's creativity, intellectual skills and imagination.
