

MAKING A MOVING PUPPET

Materials needed :

- paper or cardboard
- wool
- split pins

Your students will have to :

- * Draw the different parts of the body of a person or an animal.
- * Colour them in and cut the parts out.
- * Paste wool for hair.
- * Use a hole punch to make holes in the body joints.
- * Join the body parts together with split pins.

You can use this puppet to work with commands, abilities or actions taking place at the moment of speaking, together with the parts of the body.

Ask your students to give the puppet a name.

Tell them to make the puppet perform the actions as you name them, e.g.:

"Mr. Puppet can raise his hand."

"Mr. Puppet can jump."

"Mr. Puppet, put up your hands !"
