

SOME GAMES

Aim: - to recognize animals, communicate and express their names , habitats and characteristics.

LOOKING FOR PAIRS

Materials needed : - small pieces of paper / - a pencil or a pen.
It is essential to have enough room to move around in this activity.
If it is necessary put the chairs together or go out to the playground.

* Write the names of animals on different cards.

* There must be 2 cards for each animal.

*Each child picks up a card. He/She has to act representing the animal written on the card.

He/She mustn't talk or make any sound.

* Each child has to find the partner who has the same animal and say the name of the animal they have..

MEMO - ANIMAL

Materials needed : animal cards

you can find a lot of cards in our Cds

* Divide the class into pairs or groups of 4 students.

* Put the cards face down on the table.

* In turns, each student will have to pick up two cards, trying to find animals that live in the same habitat (e.g.: FISH + DOLPHIN = water/sea)

* If a student can't make pairs, the cards must be left down on the table again.

* The student who finds the most number of pairs is the winner.
